

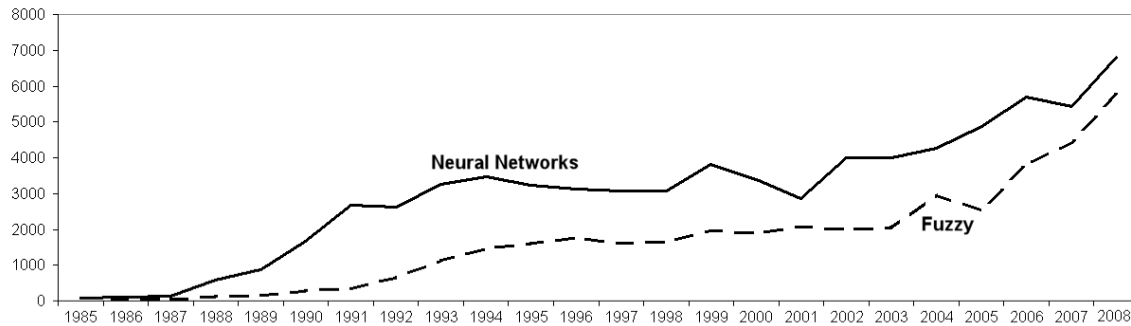

### History of the Neural Networks Committee (NN Com) : 1988

#### 1. Introduction

Figure 88.1 charts the growth of IEEE publications in Neural Networks and Fuzzy Systems from 1985 to 2008. There was a huge surge for NNs in the second half of 1987 which partially explains the interest in this field that led to the First ICNN in 1987. The area of fuzzy sets was not yet on the IEEE radar, and its more gradual growth within the IEEE began in the early 1990s (cf. the anecdote about this by Jim Bezdek, Section 7, NNC History, 1990).

1988 was the year the IEEE formally entered the NN publishing arena. NNCom held a meeting in Denver on November 28, 1988. Troy Nagle appointed a committee to propose the first NNCom archival publication, to be titled the IEEE Transactions on Neural Networks. Members of the committee were: Herb Rauch (Lockheed), Robert Newcomb (University of Maryland), Evangelia Tzanakou (Rutgers), and Robert J. Marks, Chair. Troy Nagle was elected TAB Vice President. Since the TAB VPs were not allowed to hold an officer positions in any other IEEE Organization, Troy resigned his Chair position on the NNCom. Robert J. Marks became Chairman on a temporary basis.
